CAPE Career Track Scholarship Available to CSUN Urban Studies & Planning Students

The California Association of Professional Employees (CAPE) represents more than 2,700 Los Angeles County professional employees working in hundreds of job classifications, including planners at the Department of Regional Planning. To highlight the professional opportunities for students and graduates available through the county, CAPE is sponsoring a \$2,500 scholarship for CSUN Urban Studies & Planning students.

Applicants for the scholarship must submit the following:

- a) A cover letter expressing your interest in applying for the CAPE Scholarship and allowing department faculty to review your academic record and GPA.
- b) An up-to-date resume.
- c) An essay of at least 500 words explaining your career goals. Specifically, your essay should address why you want to pursue a career in urban or regional planning, urban studies, or a closely related field (e.g., appraiser or community development). You should also identify your short and long-term career aspirations. Finally, you should also discuss any pertinent experiences you have as a volunteer, intern, or employee.
